The meeting was called to order at 6:30 p.m. by Supervisor Hogan and opened for the order of business with the Flag Salute led by Councilman James Lindsay.

A motion by Councilman Scott Lindsay, second by Councilman Akins and carried a vote of five ayes to accept the minutes from the March 7th Special Board Meeting.

Dana Hogan, Town Supervisor, thanked staff, including Cindy, Diane and Billy Jo, for their work and support.

Dana Hogan, Town Supervisor was approached by James Mumby, Town or Greenwich Supervisor if we would be willing to do a IMA with the dog control van where our dog control officer would document when they use van, then provide us with a quarterly statement payment on payback. Shannon would document the time utilizing the van on behalf of the Town of Greenwich. They will pay us for use of the van. Shannon documents when the van is being used in Fort Edward and Fort Ann to who is using it and tracks with documented hours/mileage and reimbursement at the federal mileage rate. Counselman Jim Lindsay has moved and Counselman Dan Washburn has second, all in favor.

Matt Jones, who is the Building and Grounds Director for Washington County, sent a bill for \$4,506.50 to Washington County DPW for repairs to a damaged garage door on the Fort Ann Garage at the county facility after a Town vehicle incident. Motion by Counselman Dan Washburn and Counselman Scott Lindsay has second, all in favor.

Sewer District did not respond to our Sewer District mass plan and review. Reaching out to some Engineers to see if they are interested. Tabled.

Appointing Cindy Barton to Zoning and Board of Appeals. Motioned by Counselman Dan Washburn and seconded by James Lindsay.

Mason Leonard, Highway Superintendent received an RSP for Moss Street Mowing. Sending out bids for 1 year contract rate and three-year contract rate, looking to get three bids. Put out for bid on March 17, 2026, and have back by March 27, 2026. Motion to put out to bid. Motion by Counselman Scott Lindsay and Counselman Sean Akins. All in favor.

Public Hearing amending chapter 270 opposes law. Dana Hogan, Supervisor, opened public hearing at 6:43 PM for the public to comment. No comments, public hearing is closed. Make a motion to move forward to making changes to the local law. Motion by councilman James Lindsay and second by Counselman Dan Washburn. All in favor.

AED is 2,160.61. We will talk about implementing the Town highway department. Rebecca has concerns about having someone who is qualified to operate the AED. The Highway Department is qualified as AED. This pricing comes with a one-year customer support course that will help them to get trained. One for Highway and one for Town Barn. Mason is going to ask them to get the people here set up also. Second by Sean Akins. All in favor.
